TRIPPY BULBS FOR AVANT GARDENERS



In spring, **Autumn Crocus** only produces leaves. Big leaves that soon wither and fade. But in late September when many other plants are going to seed, **Cholchicum** erupts from the Earth with abundant pink blooms that are deadly toxic to rodents and deer. The plants persist and spread year after year with little care and give you bright flower color even after leaves have fallen from your trees.



Allium aflatanense is a showy "onion" that blooms in late May or early June with baseball sized rich purple heads. It is seldom, if ever, eaten by critters and what AMAZES me is that it has self-sown in my garden to the tune of thousands of flowers without ever being weedy.
