Paeonia officinalis

This incredibly hardy Memorial Day Peony, European Peony, usually blooms just before Memorial Day. Not only are the blooms showy and but the seed display in late summer is almost as nice. We have a limited supply of #2g's grown from seeds collected in Eric's garden. There is a coupon [here](#).

Paeonia lactiflora

The super tough Chinese peonies that have adorned Truckee and Tahoe gardens for more than a century. Our late crop of #2 gallon plants with many eyes are just starting to bloom. Peony roots are graded by the number of eyes (dormant buds). These are huge vigorous plants in red, white, pink and bi-color. **Look for Spring Sale details on the website at www.villagernursery.com**
