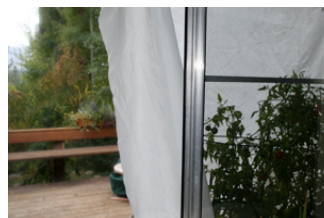
May Day
